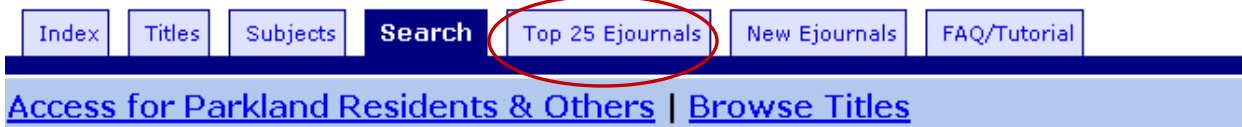

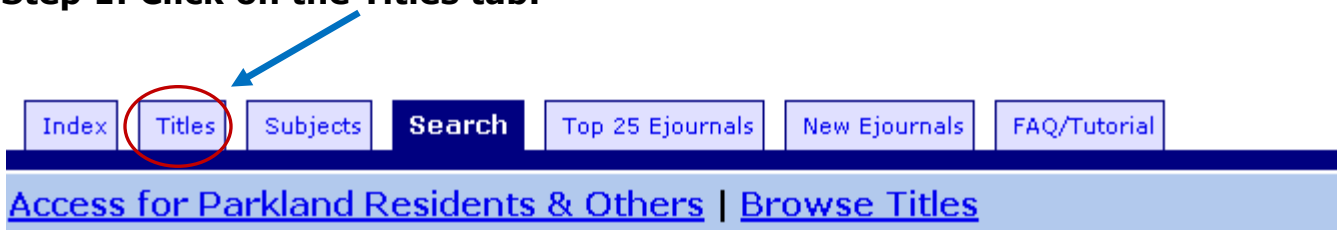
**A.** Click on the "Top 25 Ejournals" tab to view the 25 most frequently accessed ejournals at UT Southwestern.

**Q3: What is the quickest way to search for a journal title? I'm looking for "Journal of Bioscience and Engineering," 1999, volume 87.**

**A.** The quickest way to find a journal title is to use the "Search Tab" or type the journal title in the search box on the opening page.

**Step 1: Click on the "Search Tab".**

**Step 2: Type the journal title. Longer words may be truncated with an asterisk (\*).**

**Step 3: Select the appropriate options and click "Search".**

**Step 4: When the result page displays, click on the journal hyperlink. Note the time frame for which electronic access is available.**

- J-STAGE includes issues from 2000 to 2007.
- ScienceDirect includes issues from 1999 to present.

**Step 5: You are looking for a 1999 issue. Click on the ScienceDirect hyperlink.**

**Step 6: Locate the appropriate journal volume/year and then the issue and page to retrieve the desired article.**

**Q4: How can I find a 1999 issue of "Acta Anaesthesiol Scand" when I want to search by the journal abbreviation?**

**A.** From the Search page, use the asterisk (\*) truncation character after each word in the abbreviation.

**Step 1: Click on the "Search Tab".**

Note that there is an embargo on one vendor's full text access.

## Q5: What does "embargo" mean?

**A.** Embargo is a delayed time restriction the publisher places on electronic full text access to a journal title. Embargo periods vary depending on the publisher and/or journal title.

Using "Journal of Biological Physics" as an example:

Titles where title name contains 'journal of biological physics': 1  
Page list: 1. "Journal of biological physics" to "Journal of biological physics" page: 1

**Academic Search Complete** 2003 to present (Embargo: 1 year)  
**Springer Online Archives Collection** 1973 - 1996  
**SpringerLINK** 1997 to present  
ISSN: 0092-0606 Online ISSN: 1573-0689

There are 3 provider options.

- **Academic Search Premier** has a one-year embargo. This means the current year is not available.
- **Springer Online Archives Collection** has issues from 1973 to 1996.
- **SpringerLINK** has issues from 1997 to present.

To view the most current issue, you will need to select the **SpringerLINK** hyperlink.
